PLAYER CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Statement of Commitment

South's Junior Cricket Club Incorporated (SJCC Inc.) supports the rights of children and young people and is committed to providing a safe environment within which its junior members can enjoy the game of cricket. In order to support this commitment, SJCC Inc. is dedicated to our child and youth risk management strategy which has policies and procedures in place to effectively address the safety and wellbeing of children.

Preamble

South's prides itself on playing cricket within the spirit of the game. Sportsmanship is a core value of our Club. This Code of Behaviour sets out the minimum standards of behaviour for all players at South's Junior Cricket Club. These requirements apply when playing, training or taking part in club-sanctioned activities.

Policy Statement

1. Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit, not just to please parents and coaches.
2. Give your best at all times.
3. Behave in way that does not endanger your safety or the safety of others. Bring safety matters to the attention of your coach.
4. Play by the rules and within the Spirit of Cricket and show respect for the traditional values of cricket.
5. Be a good sport, treat all players as you like to be treated. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
6. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all players, including opposition players, regardless of their gender, ability, appearance, cultural background or religion. Do not make racial or other derogatory comments to or about any player.
7. Do not abuse, threaten, bully or take unfair advantage of another player. Encourage and support your team mates. Do not criticize your team mates, including for dropped catches, misfields, making a mistake, losing a game, etc.

8. Sledging, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviours by South's players.
9. Respect the decisions of umpires and match officials. Never argue with an umpire or match official.
10. Show respect for coaches, managers, game officials, team mates and opposition players. Verbal abuse is not acceptable or permitted behaviours by South's players.
11. Co-operate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
12. Show appreciation for coaches, officials, scorers and administrators. They are volunteers and without them you could not participate. Thank them after each game.
